The Oregon Chapter of the American Concrete Institute will be awarding a scholarship for the 2023-2024 Academic year. The scholarship awarded will be for \$5,000.00 and be awarded to the highest scoring applicant.

The OACI scholarship program offers a scholarship to university students who intend to pursue a career in the construction industry. Scholarships will be awarded to junior, senior, or graduate students enrolled at an Oregon university or college encompassing disciplines related to the construction industry.

### PURPOSE

This merit-based scholarship has been established to recognize and financially assist students interested in Construction management or Civil engineering.

### ELIGIBILITY

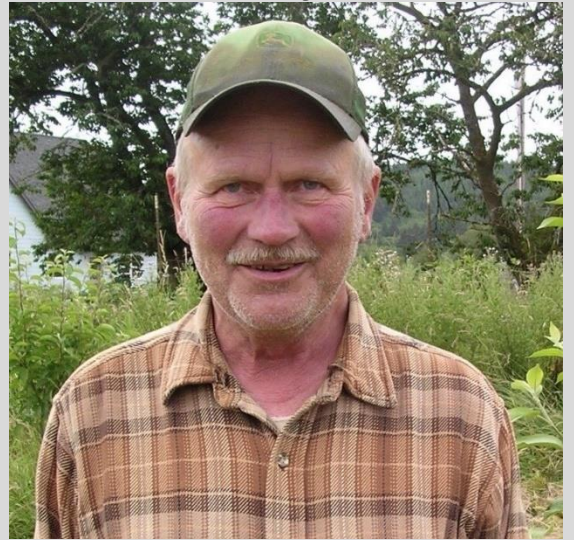
1. Applicant must be a full-time student pursuing construction management or civil engineering.
2. Applicant must have a cumulative, all-course G.P.A. 3.0 or higher.

This scholarship represents a tangible demonstration of OACI's commitment to higher education which we regard as an investment in the future of our state and the construction industry.

### PROCEDURE

1. Complete application form provided. Return the completed form to OACI by April 30<sup>th</sup>.
2. Include a letter of recommendation from a professor or employer.
3. An essay on your career plan and how it relates to the construction industry.
4. Include transcripts for all college level courses. Unofficial transcripts are acceptable for credits from previous schools. An official transcript must be provided for the school currently attending.
5. Include a current resume.
6. OACI Will select the recipient and mail the announcement before June 1<sup>st</sup>.
7. Scholarship funds will be administered by the schools Financial Aid Office.

### About Bill Maloney:



**William Carl Maloney** was born on August 6, 1939 in McMinnville, Oregon and grew up within the same region. Later, he attended both Oregon State University and the University of Oregon, majoring in mathematics. He first worked in television, serving as a cameraman and floor director for KGW Television in Portland. He then began a career in construction, started his own concrete construction company working all over the Pacific Northwest building city reservoirs, fish hatcheries, restrooms, and building foundations. He went on to become a well-respected building inspector in both Washington and Oregon. Through his estate, Bill left generous donations to both the Oregon Chapter and National ACI organizations to help students planning a career in the industry he loved pursue their education.
